

ETT Case Report 2 Wound Healing with Elastic Therapeutic Tape

History:

Male, FF D.O.B. 1986

This young man had an accident with his scooter on 18.6.2006

The doctor prescribed zinc ointment for the wound. In the following two weeks oedema started to develop in upper extremity causing restricted movement of elbow and shoulder joints.

Therapy:

Therapy goal was to influence lymph flow and increase circulation. Lymph tape application using 10% stretch. Tape Yellow, Medi-Tape®

1st Consult 30.6.2006: Lymph tape application was applied on the meridians to influence energy flow also.



2nd Session 8. 7.2006 a small tape was applied around the wound.

Oedema had disappeared, lymph application was no longer necessary and ROM of elbow and shoulder joints were back to normal



3rd. Session Friday 14.7.2006. Wound assessment and end of therapy



In this case tape was applied twice, once a week. No other therapy modalities used. Result is an outstanding wound healing using Elastic Therapeutic Tape!
